

dslr auto focus vs manual focus making the right choice - if the camera lens has a switch for moving between manual focus and autofocus it usually will be labeled with an m manual and an a auto however some lenses include an m a mode which is autofocus with a manual focus override option, **3 autofocus vs manual focus top seven considerations** - 3 autofocus vs manual focus the majority of lenses being manufactured today are capable of being used in either autofocus or manual focus mode canon does not make a single lens for their dslr cameras that isn't capable of both this wasn't always the case before canon helped pioneer autofocus systems it produced all manual focus fd, **manual focus or autofocus for landscape photography** - again with the right technique manual focus and autofocus photos are indistinguishable it just requires some extra care and usually some extra time to find your focus point manually that said there are more differences between the two lenses you mention than just focusing the tamron is the more versatile option speaking purely from, **skills in practice auto focus vs manual focus a field** - today i'll be offering you just a few tips and an insight into the world of autofocus and manual focus one could say the new age of photography and technological advancement has kinda made us just a tad bit lazy as photographers remember getting your first dslr and shooting in auto and witness, **when is manual focus better than auto focus** - so when is manual focus better than auto focus let me start by saying there is no right or wrong time to use either manual or auto focusing both can produce great results in almost all circumstances however there are a few times when you might find it easier to switch to manual focusing these include macro work, **manual focus or automatic focus capture landscapes** - while manual focus works equally on most cameras and lenses autofocus does not the autofocus quality is different on most cameras and lenses and it's often related to the product price if you compare autofocus of a cheap camera and an expensive one you may be surprised to see exactly how big the difference might be, **should i use manual focus or autofocus setting** - when i first began doing landscape photography i ignored using auto focus on my lenses and would use manual focus exclusively being that i was transitioning from a wildlife photographer to shooting mostly landscapes i had assumed that the af switch on my lenses had seen their last days after a, **shifting from autofocus to manual focus on your canon eos** - your canon eos rebel t3 1100d offers an excellent autofocus system however with some subjects such as low contrast scenes like foggy mornings autofocus can be slow or impossible which is why your camera also offers manual focusing make the shift from auto to manual focus as follows set the af mf switch on the side of the, **5 situations when manual focus is better than auto focus** - one way to overcome this is to switch to manual focusing and pre focus on a point that the subject will move through and shooting at that point you need to get your timing just right but you'll find that it'll often give better results than relying upon auto focus modes particularly if you shoot in continuous shooting burst mode, **autofocus vs manual focus when to use each** - often the camera never really settles on a focus point this is a great time to use your manual focus if you know what you want to focus on but it falls between the autofocus's pre set focal points manual focus is your answer i often find this happens when focusing on a small area of my subject such as the eyelashes in a close up, **manual focus vs auto focus which wins for the street** - so autofocus or manual focus i've laid out the factors that i feel have the most impact on either technique which one you choose really boils down to personal preference some street photographers use manual focus all the time they zone focus and never worry about missing a shot, **autofocus modes explained photography life** - use manual focus kind of goes against the title of this article but you should still learn how to manually focus your lenses and not be afraid to do it sometimes manually focusing your lens is quicker than trying to use any of the autofocus methods many landscape macro and architecture photographers shoot with manual focus lenses, **ten reasons when manual focus is better than auto focus** - techniques ten reasons when manual focus is better than auto focus here are ten situations when manual focus can work better than your camera's auto focus
